

Cuyahoga County 2019 Annual Plan
Draft Second Amendment
Posted for Public Comment on October 5, 2020

This Second Amendment to Cuyahoga County's 2019 Annual Plan states the planned use of a second allocation of Community Development Block Grant funds under the CARES Act.

Cuyahoga County first received an allocation of \$2,432,345 in CDBG-CV1 funds for the express purpose of responding to Covid-19 and related economic downturn and recovery, available for residents of 51 suburbs making up the Cuyahoga Urban County.

\$1,200,000 of its CDBG-CV1 funds received provide assistance to renters, who lost income due to the economic impact of COVID-19, for up to 3 months, based on need and income eligibility.

\$1,232,345 of CDBG=CV1 funds received provide assistance in the form of grants and loans to small businesses economically affected by Covid-19.

Cuyahoga County has now received an additional allocation of \$2,735,278 of CDBG-CV3 funds for the express purpose of responding to Covid-19 and related economic downturn and recovery, available for residents of 51 suburbs making up the Cuyahoga Urban County.

\$2,000,000 of its CDBG-CV3 funds received will provide mortgage assistance to homeowners who have been negatively affected economically by Covid-19,

\$500,000 of its CDBG-CV3 funds will be used to provide food assistance.

\$235,278 of its CDBG-CV3 funds will be used to provide outreach to the community of the assistance programs available and administration of same.

The total allocation of CDBG-CV funds to Cuyahoga County to date is \$5,167,623.00
